

St. Kevin/St. Benedict Religious Education Policies Grades 1-8

- Attending Mass and receiving the Eucharist is an important part of our Catholic faith. Parents, we humbly ask for your partnership in teaching your children the importance of mass by bringing them to church.
- When children are late to class, it is disruptive to both the teacher and other students. School doors will be closed and locked after 8:55 a.m.
- Please drop off and pick up children in the school's back parking lot at the double doors. This is for the safety of the students, and to avoid blocking neighborhood streets.
- Students in grades 1-5 must be picked up at classrooms by 9:50 a.m. by an adult, or a sibling also attending CCD in grades 6-8 only. Since some of our teachers go to 10 a.m. mass, please be on time. Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will be escorted by their teachers to the double doors for dismissal.
- **UPDATED:** If your child is absent, please read that week's chapter with your child and complete the chapter activity. Worksheets must be returned to Christine Reilly, Director of Religious Education (DRE).
- **NEW:** After three absences, a meeting with the DRE will be required. This may result in your child repeating the grade.
- **NEW:** Cell phone use is not allowed during class.
- Families must be registered at either parish in order for children to attend religious education classes. Parish registration form: <http://saintkevinri.org/wp-content/uploads/Registration-Form.pdf>
- Religious education registration forms, fees, and baptismal certificates must be submitted before the first day of class. If any documents or fees are missing, the registration will be mailed back to parents for corrections. Once all documents are received and approved by the DRE, your child may attend CCD. A late fee of \$10 will be assessed for any registration received after Sept 30. Please speak directly with Fr. Marciano or Deacon John about fee waivers. If fees are waived for the school year, Fr. Marciano or Deacon John must sign the registration form.
