

## St. Kevin/St. Benedict Religious Education Policies Grades 1-8

- Classes meet on scheduled Sundays at St. Kevin School from 8:50 a.m. to 9:50 a.m. Download the 2017-18 class schedule: <http://saintkevinri.org/wp-content/uploads/ccd-2017-2018-class-dates.pdf>
- Attending Mass and receiving the Eucharist is an important part of our Catholic faith. Parents, we humbly ask for your partnership in teaching your children the importance of mass by bringing them to church.
- When children are late to class, it is disruptive to both the teacher and other students. School doors will be closed and locked after 8:55 a.m.
- Please drop off and pick up children in the school's back parking lot. The double doors near the garage door will be open. This is for the safety of the students, and to avoid blocking neighborhood streets.
- Students in grades 1-5 must be picked up in their classrooms by 9:50 a.m. by an adult, or a sibling also attending CCD in grades 6-8 only. Also, since some of our teachers go to 10 a.m. mass, please be on time. Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will be escorted by their teachers to the school back door near the garage for dismissal.
- **UPDATED:** If your child misses a class, please read that week's chapter with your child at home. The chapter activity worksheet must be completed and returned to Christine Reilly, Director of Religious Education the following week.
- **NEW:** A meeting with the Director of Religious Education will be required after three missed classes. This may result in your child repeating the grade.
- **NEW:** Using cell phones is not allowed during class. This includes texting, playing games, and Web browsing.
- Families must be registered at St. Kevin or St. Benedict in order for children to attend religious education classes. Parish registration form: <http://saintkevinri.org/wp-content/uploads/Registration-Form.pdf>
- Religious education registration forms, fees, and baptismal certificates must be submitted before the first day of class. If any part of the registration form is incomplete, the baptismal certificate is not received, or registration fee is not included, the registration form will be mailed back to parents for appropriate corrections. Once the required documents are received and approved by the Director of Religious Education, your child may attend class. If there is a financial need for any family, you will need to speak with Fr. Marciano or Deacon John so that the registration fee can be waived for the year. If the fee is waived, Fr. Marciano or Deacon John must sign at the bottom of registration form.
