

St. Kevin/St. Benedict Religious Education Policies Grades 1-8

- Classes meet on scheduled Sundays at St. Kevin School from 8:50 a.m. to 9:50 a.m.

- Attending Mass and receiving the Eucharist is an important part of our Catholic faith. Parents, we humbly ask for your partnership in teaching your children the importance of Mass by bringing them to church.
- When children are late to class, it is disruptive to both the teacher and other students. Doors will be closed and locked after 8:55 a.m.
- Please drop off and pick up children in the school's back parking lot. The double doors near the garage door will be open. This is for the safety of the students, and to avoid blocking neighborhood streets.
- Students in grades 1-5 must be picked up in their classrooms by 9:50 a.m. by an adult, or a sibling also attending CCD in grades 6-8 only. Also, since some of our teachers go to 10 a.m. mass, please be on time. Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 will be escorted by their teachers to the school back door near the garage for dismissal.
- **NEW:** If your child misses a class, please read the missed chapter with your child at home. They must return the completed activity sheet at the end of the chapter to their teacher the following week.
- **NEW:** A meeting with the Director of Religious Education will be required after three missed classes. This may result in your child repeating the grade.
- **NEW:** Using cell phones is not allowed during class. This includes texting, playing games, and Web browsing.
- Families must be registered at St. Kevin's or St. Benedict's in order for children to attend religious education classes. Download parish registration forms: <http://saintkevinri.org/wp-content/uploads/Registration-Form.pdf>
- Religious education registration forms, fees, and baptismal certificates must be submitted before Oct. 1, the first day of class. Children baptized at St. Kevin's do not need to provide baptismal certificates. All documents must be submitted prior to Oct. 1 or children will not be allowed to attend class. Once the required documents are received and reviewed by the Director of Religious Education, your child may attend classes.
