+ ASH WEDNESDAY: Wednesday, March 6

This is a day of Fast and Abstinence. The Season of Lent, 40 days of fasting, prayer and almsgiving, begins today. Ashes will be distributed at the conclusion of Mass. Masses will be celebrated at 7:45 AM and 6:00 PM at St. Kevin Church and at 10:00 AM at Randall Holden School with St. Kevin students and faculty.

+ STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Fridays at 10:00 AM (with St. Kevin School students) beginning March 22 and at 6:30 PM with Benediction
