PRAYER TO BE SAID IN LIGHT OF THE CORONA VIRUS

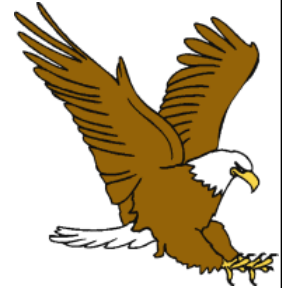

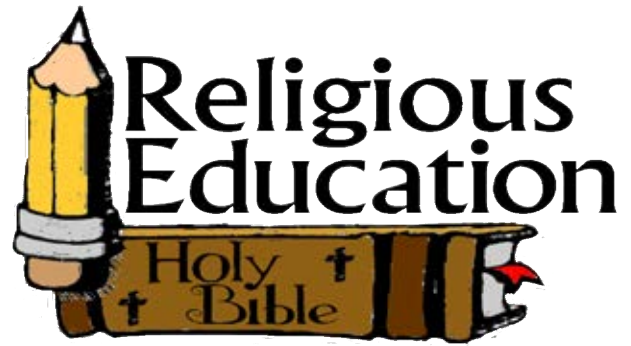

1st Communion (CCD students only) Saturday, July 25th at 10am

First Communion (CCD students only) is going to be on Saturday 7/25/20 at 10am. Each child making First Communion will only be allowed 4 guests each due to seating capacity in the church which follow social distancing guidelines by the Governor. Face mask coverings need to be worn by all (people will be allowed to lower masks when receiving Communion only). Children will sit with parents/guardians only. Ideally, we would like 2nd grade students and parents to be seated in the middle two aisles of the Church on each end of every pew that is open for usage. You can sit two students/parents per pew with family sitting at each end of pew (one family at each end of pew). Guests will sit in any other available pews. Seating will be done on a first come first served basis for all. We will have a photographer, Bob Fontaine, (taking photos of your child making their First Communion. We ask that everyone leave after the First Communion ceremony and not congregate to keep everyone safe.

Certificates for both First Reconciliation and First Communion will be mailed out.

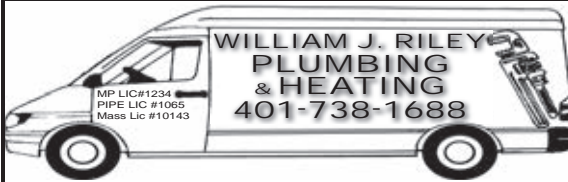
