

St. Kevin/St. Benedict Religious Education Policies Grades 1-8

- Classes meet Sundays at St. Kevin School from 8:50 am to 9:50 am. The class schedule can be found on the St. Kevin's website on the religious education tab.
- Attending Mass and receiving the Eucharist is an important part of our Catholic faith. Parents, we humbly ask for your partnership in teaching your children the importance of mass by bringing them to church. Children cannot learn about their faith during CCD alone.
- When children are late to class, it is disruptive to both the teacher and other students. School doors will be closed and locked at 9:00 am.
- Please drop off and pick up children in the school's back parking lot at the double doors.
- Children in grades 1-5 must be escorted to their classroom by either an adult, or a siblings also attending CCD in grades 6-8 only. This is for the safety of the students, and to avoid blocking neighborhood streets.
- Children in grades 1-5 must be picked up at classrooms by 9:50 am by an adult, or a sibling also attending CCD in grades 6-8 only. Since some of our teachers go to 10:00 am mass, please be on time. Students in grades 6-8 will be escorted by their teachers to the double doors for dismissal.
- If your child is absent, please email Christine Reilly at ccddirector@saintkevinri.org for chapter and makeup work that will need to be turned in at next class.
- After three absences without makeup work being turned in, a meeting with DRE will be required. This may result in your child repeating the grade.
- Cell phone use is not allowed during class.
- Parents are responsible for any damage their child(ren) cause to St. Kevin School property. Please talk with your child(ren) about respecting school and SKS students' personal property.
- Please speak directly with Fr. Marciano or Deacon Fulton about registration fees being waived. If fees are waived, have Deacon Fulton or Fr. Marciano initial front of this form.
- A late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed for any registration received after Oct 8, 2018.
